If a competitor has to take any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited list for a medical condition, then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

FREQUENCIES:

Following frequencies are expected for the disposal:

27 MHz, 35 MHz, 40 MHz, 72 MHz, 2.4 GHz

Every competitor must register two frequencies for every transmitter except for 2.4 GHz spread spectrum devices.

FLIGHT ALTITUDE MEASUREMENTS BY ELECTRONIC ALTIMETERS

Rules

Flight altitudes in all altitude classes (S1A and S5B for Juniors and S1B and S5C for Seniors) shall be measured by electronic altimeters in accordance with the FAI Sporting Code, Section 4, Volume ABR, paragraph B.12 and Volume Space Models, paragraph 4.9.2.1.

"Local Rules for the Contest Process in Space Models Altitude Competition in Classes S1 and S5" as approved by the CIAM Bureau on 5th December, 2009 were given in Annex 1 of Bulletin No 1.

Electronic altimeters to be used in altitude classes competitions

All flights shall be measured by the same type of the electronic altimeters produced by the same producer: **ALT-USB** made by **ADREL Company** (Poland). The altimeters are tested and have certificate for use in national and international competitions issued by the producer's National Airsports Control. These devices are selected after the organizer's "Invitation for offers for electronic altimeters to be used for altitude measurements in the FAI World Space Models Championships 2010" conducted in January 2010.

Electronic Altimeters of the same type produced by the same producer shall ensure the organizer for all sportsmen to compete in these Championships.

Technical data for electronic altimeters ALT-USB are given in Annex 1 of this Bulletin No 2 as provided by the producer of these devices.



Altimeter Guidelines and Competition Tips

"Altimeter Guidelines and Competition Tips" were published in "Local Rules for the Contest Process in Space Models Altitude Competition in Classes S1 and S5" given in Annex 1 of Bulletin No 1.

Technical solutions for application of electronic altimeters are subjected to ideas and skills of competitors and must be in compliance with the rules for electronic altimeters. Since there is a wide spectrum of technical solutions and ideas for these applications, the organizers shall post at its site http://www.mksirmium.com a document Guidelines for electronic altimeter that contains compilation of interesting solutions collected over last months from different countries to ease every competitor to find the most appropriate design for his/her models.

Leszek Swed from Adrel Company, the designer of the ALT-USB devices to be used in this Championships, after recent test flights and test competitions came to the following conclusion that a hole on the container's top should be only 0.8 mm (see Option 1 in Guidelines for Electronic Altimeter) not 3 mm as it was in earlier practice. In case if there are vent holes on the models body (Options 2 and 3) there should be 3 euqual vent holes with diameters from 0.3 to 0.5 mm

Deposit

Every team shall submit, at registration, a deposit of 40 Euros for each altimeter that will be issued. The deposit must be paid in cash before the contest starts. The deposit shall be returned when the altimeters and batteries are returned. If an altimeter and battery is not returned, or is damaged, the deposit shall be retained.

If all altimeters per team are lost, during a competition, a new deposit must be paid to allow the team to continue in the competition.

Post Contest Activities

Based on the criteria established in the pre-contest organization the altimeters, chargers and batteries shall be sold or distributed.
